#### **Best Times of the Year to Visit:**

The best period to visit Fiji is from May to October, when dry, sunny weather is most reliable. During these months, temperatures are warm but not too hot, rainfall is low, and ocean conditions are calm.

#### What to Pack:

Bring reef-safe sunscreen, swimwear, insect repellent, and light clothing. Sturdy sandals and a waterproof bag are also useful. You can also find specific items to bring on each of our tour pages.
